

F1 Telemetry Data Processing System

A data engineering platform that ingests real Formula 1 data via the Fast F1 Api, stores it in PostgreSQL, simulates a "real time" race and processes this data through 2 parallel processing architectures (Lambda and Kappa) to compute lap time metrics per driver. Results are served via RestAPI and visualised on a web frontend.
